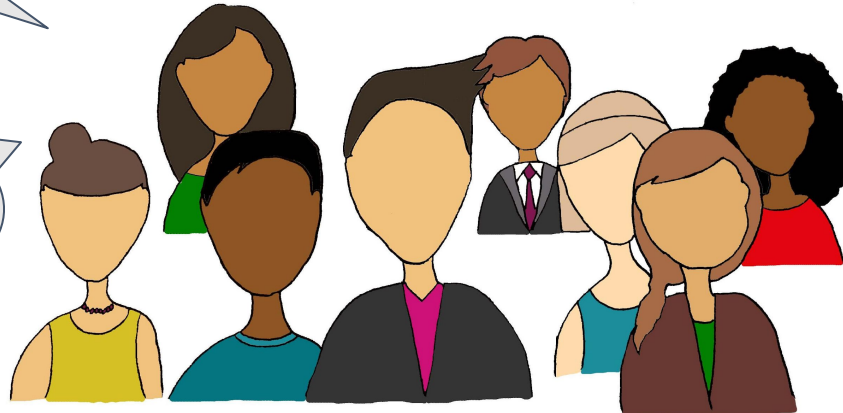

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Case Studies

Student 1: current 9th grade. Liked Art and Code, Intro to Programming classes, likes math. Thought about robotics but too shy to do it this year. Likes to write, but not a fan of Harkness discussions. Loves to talk politics at the dinner table. Likes soccer, is good at it, but missed tryouts in the fall. Did one community partnership at The Winch.

Student 2: current 11th grade. Member of Social Justice Council and Debate. Thinks they might want to study archeology or museum conservation in college. Also interested in environmental science. Loves to travel. Wants to learn scuba diving. Family reunion scheduled - 2 weeks in Vancouver.

Student 3: current 10th grade. Wants to be a nurse or athletic trainer but parents want pre-med. Loves biology. Really involved in community partnerships. Wants AP studio art in 12th grade - really good at illustration Also loves field hockey and might be good enough to play D3. Wants to earn money this summer.

Student 4: current 10th grade. Has been going to same summer camp in Maine for 8 years. Loves the outdoors. Wants to earn a pilot's license. Is 2 year member of crew team. Is involved in MUN and *The Standard* at ASL. Thinks they might want to study psychology or international relations and history either in US or UK.

Student 5: current 9th grade. Violin ABRSM grade 6, ASL and outside orchestra. Likes Yearbook class and wants to be on *The Standard* staff next year. Has own cooking blog online with 400 followers; wants to start a club next year.. Loved Science 9 and earned A+ first semester. Teacher has encouraged student to explore science research.

Student 6: current 10th grade. Has travelled with family for the last three summers, stays with grandparents for a month each summer. Is good at English, band and social studies. Did not like Science 9 but really likes Science 10. Plays JJV basketball. Has done 1 Community Partnership - Adventure Playground.
