This is your invitation to get your State Pension.

Applying online is the quickest and easiest way to get your State Pension. Go to **www.gov.uk/get-state-pension**

You will need:

1. Your unique invitation code: SAN854NQ7X
2. The date of your most recent marriage, civil partnership or divorce
3. Dates of time spent living or working abroad
4. Your personal or joint bank or building society account details

If you cannot get online, call 0800 731 7898 to apply for your State Pension over the phone. You can also call to get a State Pension claim form posted to you.

What you will get

How much State Pension you get depends on your National Insurance record.

You can check your record, see how much you can get and if you can increase the amount at [**www.gov.uk/check-state-pension**](http://www.gov.uk/check-state-pension)

If you do not want to get your State Pension right now

You do not have to do anything. You will not get any State Pension until you claim it. You may get extra money if you delay claiming your State Pension. We call this deferring.
